Society's Responsibility

1. DAMAGE THROUGH EXHIBITS. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibit and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from such accidents.

2. ACCIDENTS. The Society will not under any circumstance hold itself liable for any accident on the grounds or premises.

3. DAMAGE TO EXHIBITS. The Society will not under any circumstance hold itself responsible for any loss or damage to, or misdelivery of exhibits.

4. LOSS BY DISEASE. The entry form will be taken as a guarantee that the animals therein are free from all disease so far as it is known by the owner. In case of infectious disease being spread through, or by an exhibit, the exhibitor will be held responsible.

5. FIRE. Precautions will be taken to guard against fire, and to protect the property at the Show, but exhibits will not be insured at the cost of the Society.

6. NO ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED EXCEPT ON THE CONDITION THAT all disputes, objections and protests, shall be decided by the committee of the Show Society, whose decision will be final.

NO ENTRY WILL BE RECEIVED FROM ANY PERSON DISQUALIFIED BY THE QLD CHAMBER OF AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES during the period of such disqualification. Should such an entry be accidentally accepted, it shall when discovered, be deemed void and the entry fee shall be forfeited.

OWNERS OF STOCK ARE REMINDED TO AFFECT THEIR OWN INSURANCE POLICY FOR ANY COVER THEY DEEM NECESSARY FOR THE SHOW.

6. Riders can only run for either Official Highest Scoring Rider or Unofficial Highest Scoring Rider.
