2. Entrants must only enter in their own age group and be clearly labeled including under or over 16
3. Names of all varieties of grain must be stated on entry form as well as card inserted in samples. Samples to be in no less than 2 litre ice cream containers. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
4. The Exhibits in the Grain and Sheave section to be judged on their quality, weight, size, plumpness, evenness and colour.
5. All exhibits in grain and sheaves section must be produced or manufactured by the exhibitor and must be in marketable condition. High Moisture grain not eligible for prizes.
6. Three or more entries or no second place.
7. Fruit and Vegetable entries are required to obtain a 3 cm stalk or be on vine for judging purposes
8. Eggs to be displayed in a half dozen egg carton
9. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor
10. All honey to be displayed in a 400 ml glass jar
11. Nominations to be paid and paperwork completed at the Dalby Show Society Office
12. All wax and honeycomb to be displayed in a clear sealed container
13. Entries cannot be removed until 8:00 am Sunday
14. Dalby & District Show Society reserves the right to retain any items not collected by 10 am
15. Prize money must be collected from the payout office by 5 pm Saturday 11th April 2026
