**Overall, Champion of Section Achieved by accumulating the most points across all classes in needlework**

- All work must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor and must not have been laundered
- Back of work must be visible except for framed items
- Exhibits cannot be entered for more than one class at a time
- Each exhibit to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified
- Distinct, where specified, means a completely different variety or type
- Any soiled needlework will not be considered for judging
- No award will be made in any class if the work is below standard (this is at the discretion of the judge)
- Exhibits can be entered for two (2) years only. If the exhibit has won first prize it is no longer permitted to be entered
- All care will be of exhibits by the Show Society, but any loss or damage whatsoever will be the responsibility of the exhibitor
- Entries cannot be removed until 8 am Sunday 13th April 2026. The Dalby Show Society reserves the right to retain any items not collected by 10 am Sunday 13th April 2026
- Prize money must be collected from the pay out office by 5 pm Saturday 12th April 20
